

Dear Parents and Community Members,

We had our first Kinder Orientation Day for our 2020 Kinder students. They were all quite excited to be at school for the day. If there are any other children in the community who are old enough for Kinder in 2020, we would be happy for them to come along and experience some days at Long Flat School, even if they have plans to go elsewhere next year.

Remember the Parent Health forum at school tomorrow, *Wednesday 6th November*. This starts at 9:30am in the room near our large COLA (tennis court). Feel free to park your car over near the multi-sports court.

Swimming Scheme

Swimming is due to start on Friday 8th November. Please make sure your child has all necessary equipment each day we have swimming including: dry underwear to change into after swimming, rash shirt or other shirt to swim in, water bottle, hat, and personal sunscreen if you don't want them to use the cream supplied by the school.

Students need to bring their recess and lunches on swimming days. The school canteen is closed and they will not be given access to the canteen at the pool. Students will be given the opportunity to buy something from the pool canteen on the very last day of swimming.

Picking Children up from the Pool

Occasionally parents pick their children up from the pool. If you tell us that you will be picking your child up, please check with the school to find out what times we are leaving the pool. These might vary from day to day. If a parent has not arrived by the time we leave, we will NOT be leaving your child at the pool. You will have to pick them up at school.

Also note that students generally take their swimming gear in a strong plastic or material bag and <u>not in their school bag</u>. This helps to keep swimming gear separate from other items in their bags.

School bags are not normally taken to the pool. So if you are picking your child up from the pool you will need to remind them (and the school) that they will need to take their school bag to the pool on that day.

The transition to high school program starts this week on Wednesday 6th November. Year 6 students are to meet in the High School library at 2.00p.m.

If your child is being picked up by a friend or relative, please contact the school to let us know well before pick-up time. Also make them aware that they need to come up to the assembly area to pick up your child. At the same time they can remind us they are here to pick up your child.
