COVID-19 ~ sick children reminder

Parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Students and staff with flu-like symptoms will need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test will not be permitted to return to school for a 10 day period. Additionally, they must be symptom-free for at least 3 days prior to returning to school.

Following the latest Department of Education / NSW Health COVID-19 guidelines, we have planned the following events or activities to take place during the remainder of the year. Unfortunately, some details and organisational aspects will need to be different to how they been in the past:
