

Struggle

- •Help your child become curious about errors or lack of success. Remind your child that failure is important on the way to success. Model (practice and demonstrate in your own behaviour) this!
- •Show your child the Michael Jordan Failure commercial https://goo.gl/nnsjsA and talk to your child about what the last line of the video means.
- Provide some puzzles and games that may create a little struggle for your child. Work together and discuss why struggle shows that you are learning and that
